**WHEREAS**, the need to remove bitterness from our hearts and to ask for forgiveness and to forgive one another is essential in living healthy and happy lives, and


**WHEREAS**, the need to repair, restore, rebuild and revive damaged relationships is very important for true love and joy to exist in the hearts people
